

**Pineapple Express 2009  
Information on Trailer Parking and Canoe Loading/Unloading**



**There will be free parking for trailers on the golf course on Saturday, starting at 5:30 am.**

For trailers arriving Friday before 9:00 pm:

- West on Avila Beach Dr.
- Left on San Miguel St.
- Right on 1<sup>st</sup> St.
- Right on Avila Beach Dr.
- Park on south side of Avila Beach Dr. between San Juan St. and San Miguel St.

Unload canoes next morning by making the same loop onto San Miguel St. and offloading canoes on 1st St. just before it hits San Juan St.. Then park as directed on golf course.

Trailers arriving after 9:00 pm on Friday night can do the same thing, but will offload canoes on 1st St. before San Juan St., and dolly canoes to beach (beach access at end of San Juan St., and then to the right, across sand, and under bridge, so that they are not on Port San Luis property, but instead are on private property north of the bridge). Then trailers go to Avila Beach Drive, make a right, and park on south side of street.

Trailers arriving Saturday AM turn left on San Juan St., and then will be directed to unload canoes either 1) on San Juan St., 2) on Front St., or 3) on 1<sup>st</sup> St.

After the race, canoes will be dollied across Avila Beach Dr. and into the golf course to be loaded on trailers. No trailers may be driven onto Avila Beach streets for canoe loading.

Notes:

- We must make every effort not to impact traffic flow on Friday night at Avila Beach (there is a Farmer's Market going on).
- We can't park trailers or any cars on the golf course on Friday night--this'd cause problems with our permit, the Port, the County, etc.
- Clubs with several canoes may want to consider bringing 2 dollies for transporting the canoes after the race from the beach to the golf course.
- If you pass San Juan Street on Avila Beach Dr., you can go 3 miles west and turn around at the Port San Luis Pier and then return west on Avila Beach Dr.
