REGISTRATION

COST

Tuition

Per full-day, 3-week session:

- \$695 if application is received by Monday, May 1, 2006
- \$745 if application is received May 2 - Monday, May 15
- \$795 if application is received Tuesday, May 16 or later

Per half-day, 3-week session:

- \$515 if application is received by Monday, May 1, 2006
- \$565 if application is received May 2 - Monday, May 15
- \$615 if application is received Tuesday, May 16 or later

Deposit

- \$400 per child for full-day, 3-week session
- \$200 per child for half-day, 3-week session
- 25% of deposit non-refundable if we can offer your child a space.
- 100% of deposit refunded if we cannot offer your child a space.

Balance Due

- Tuition minus deposit is due Monday, May 15, 2006.
If you sign up after May 15, full tuition is due when you sign-up

ACCEPTANCE

- Camp applicants are accepted on a FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS, with minor adjustments for age and gender balance.
- Acceptance letters will be mailed by Friday, May 5 for registrations received by May 1; thereafter, we will notify as registrations are received. If you provide your e-mail address, we will also notify you by e-mail.
- If your registration arrives after camp is full for a given session and age group, we will contact you by phone immediately .

Refund

- 25% of the deposit is non-refundable if we can offer your child a space.
- The balance of deposit and tuition are non-refundable after Monday, May 15, 2006.

Counselors-in-Training

All cost information above applies to CITs. Please note that CITs must sign up for the full-day program.

- Notification of acceptance into the CIT program: Friday, May 5.
Teen Camp acceptance is first come-first served, but acceptance into the CIT program is based on a camper's behavior in the prior summer as a camper.

SESSIONS 1, 2, & 3

CIT AFTERNOON PROGRAM

CITs work with the Elementary Camp from 1:00-4:00 pm daily and meet with their supervisor 4:00-4:30 pm weekly. Only those teens who are alumni and have applied for the CIT program and been accepted are involved in the CIT program. All other teens may attend the Teen Camp and take courses and participate in teen afternoon workshops.

Session 3

Play Production plus

In addition to a selection of our typical courses, the campers will prepare a dramatic production. Students will participate in an intensive training and make the images and language of the play come alive with strong characterizations, based on their work in physical movement and text. Campers will prepare the sets and costumes.

Our August session is an opportunity for students to focus intensely on their special interests. In past years, for instance, particularly extensive animated films have been completed during this session. Campers may take a mixture of the classes listed above but may want to emphasize several.
